Guatemala Trip: From Feb 15-22, Ellen, Marcin, Guy, and Kimberly participated in the District 6930 work trip to Ak'Tenamit, a vocational boarding school in Guatemala that transforms the lives of impoverished Mayan youth and addresses the root causes of illegal immigration. They participated in strategic planning and marketing efforts, taught CPR and art, and completed site planning for a new water distribution project desperately needed at the school. Currently all water used by 700+ students depends on one aging pump, and water storage is very limited. These trips are transformational experiences and they occur each February. One first-time visitor from the Lake Worth Rotary Club was so impressed she made a generous donation to increase the school's internet access and is arranging for much-needed

medical supplies to be delivered to the school's clinic.

The Interact club completed their first-ever food drive and raffle at the high school. The food drive occurred Feb 4-6 and collected 100 items for a local food pantry run by Lutheran Church of the Resurrection. Many thanks to our club members who brought in canned goods for their drive. The students plan to make this a yearly tradition.
