Guatemala Trip Highlights

Kimberly, Guy, Jo and Ellen went to Ak Tenamit school in Guatemala the week of February 15th. Ak Tenamit is a vocational education center that full scholarships to over 700 students from poor Mayan communities and teaches them the skills to have a good life in Guatemala. The trip was very good. Jo planned improvements for the on-site clinic with other members of the medical team and taught the students and counselors about first aid. Ellen did some translation, worked on the plan for reaching out to Taiwanese Rotarians at the Rotary International conference in Taipei and suggested some enhancements to the tours at the school. a lot about the existing water and sewage system and areas where we can add value. We were very impressed with the in-house construction of two new ferrocement 60,000 liter water tanks. The second tank construction was completed while we were on site and was successfully leak tested. These two tanks are Phase I of the water upgrade. Phase II Water consists of new solar panels and pump and water distribution system and is funded at \$50,000+. and will start soon. The school is looking into a Phase III Water RI Global Grant for additional water storage, distribution, water treatment and sewage treatment.
